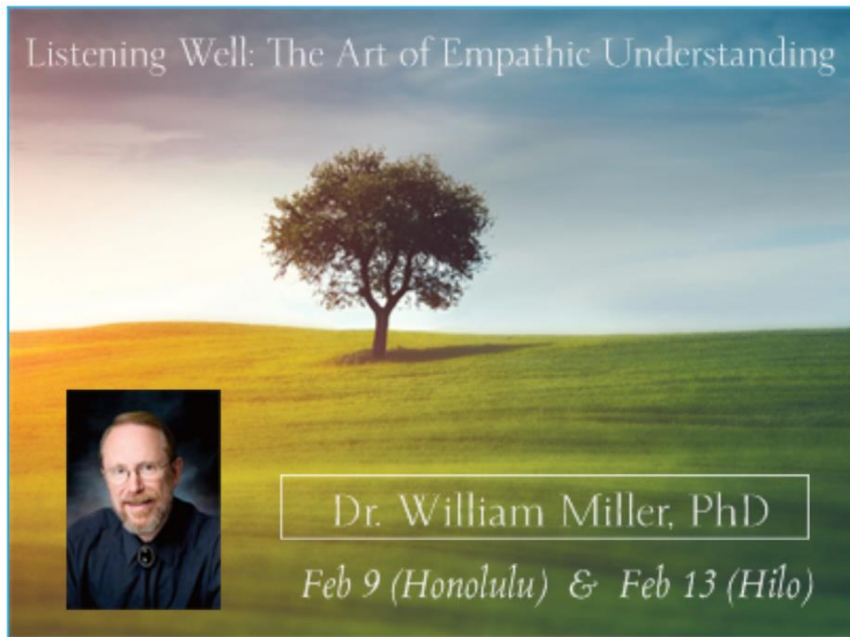


# Listening Well: The Art of Empathic Understanding

**Dr. William R. Miller** is Emeritus Distinguished Professor of Psychology and Psychiatry at the University of New Mexico. He has focused on the development, testing and dissemination of behavioral treatments. With 45 years of research experience in treatment, he has served as principal investigator for numerous grants and contracts, served as a consultant to many organizations including the US Senate, the World Health Organization, the National Academy of Sciences, and the National Institutes of Health. Dr. Miller has published over 50 books including co-authoring *Motivational Interviewing: Helping People Change*. The Institute for Scientific Information has listed Dr. Miller as one of the world's most cited scientists.
