"If you interact or work with children, you can learn simple tools to help them express their feelings and resolve disputes," says Majidah. "We'll focus on concepts and socio-emotional components of conflict prevention and resolution for kids." In this interactive talk, understand what conflict is and develop specific problem-solving skills such as perspective taking, empathy, and "I" statements for children and adults.

Majidah Lebarre earned her B.A. in Political Science from Washington State University and M.A. in International Relations from the University of Sussex in England. She has assisted The National Democratic Institute of Nepal, Mercy Corps, and American Red Cross in their missions. Majidah is the Program Coordinator at Ku'ikahi Mediation Center, where she trains youth in peer mediation and conflict resolution. She is also a professionally trained mediator.
