Since 2000, Lester D. Oshiro has been the Chief Court Administrator for the Third Circuit (Hawai'i Island) of the Hawai'i State Judiciary, which includes supervision over Circuit, Family, and District Court programs.

Previously he was the Circuit Court Administrator and Chief Clerk for the Third Circuit. He has served as the Arbitration Administrator of the Court Annexed Arbitration Program (CAAP) in the Third Circuit since its inception in 1987. In addition, he served the Hawai'i State Judiciary as a member of the Executive Committee on Technology and a recorder for the Probate Practices and Procedures Committee.

With over four decades of experience as a licensed attorney, Mr. Oshiro has also worked as a Deputy Prosecuting Attorney for the Office of the Prosecuting Attorney in East Hawai'i, Trust Officer for First Hawaiian Bank, Deputy Corporation Counsel for the County of Hawai'i, and a private attorney.

Mr. Oshiro has been a board member of the State of Hawai'i Board of Examiners, Legal Aid Society of Hawai'i, Hawai'i Island Adult Care, and Maxcorp.
